Part A: Knowledge and comprehension	 Multiple-choice Examination Learners are required to take one of the four standard assessments under examination conditions This consists of 20 questions in a variety of formats. Each paper has a maximum of 33 marks. Minimum mark required for this section is 20 out of 33 		
Part B: Practical application of learning	 Hazard Spotting Exercises This consists of four hazard-spotting questions plus four questions about the harm caused by hazards and the best ways to control it. Each paper has a maximum of 16 marks. Minimum mark required for this section is 10 out of 16 		

To be eligible for a Working safely certificate, delegates must have a total score of 30 or more
