## Course Overview

Focuses on corporate governance, resourcing and accountability structures to embed climate objectives into organisational decision-making.

Further, participants gain insights in establishing comprehensive greenhouse gas inventories across Scopes 1, 2 and 3 to accurate reporting, improve transparency, and provide a credible basis for setting science-aligned net zero targets inside their organisation and its value chain. Finally, the course guides them in developing decarbonisation plans with measurable targets to drive sustained emissions reductions and drive Net Zero commitments confidently and systematically within their organisation.

## Target Audience

Pathways to Net Zero is aimed at persons who might be:

- Responsible for developing a net zero approach (or other carbon reduction strategy) for their organisation
- Supporting an existing net zero strategy
- An environmental/sustainability specialist with net zero as a new responsibility
- Responsible for communicating or helping to communicate an organisation's net zero approach
- Responsible for decarbonising a particular part of an organisation, e.g., supply chain, business travel, estates etc.
